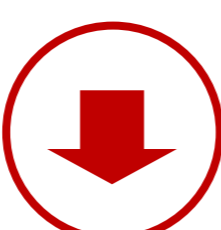
TRANSPORTING CHILDREN WITH LIMBS IN CASTS



Children with limited flexibility

Children in spica casts need special seats such as the Snug Seat Hippo, in accordance with their weight and age

The side supports are lower



Specific seat for children with limited mobility



Children with limbs in casts

If the child can sit, you can use a normal seat

The seat belt must be placed over the middle third of the clavicle



Always over the sternum



The bottom strap must be over the hip bones; be careful not to place it over the cast



You can add cushioning to support the child's leg if they cannot bend it



Children who must travel lying down

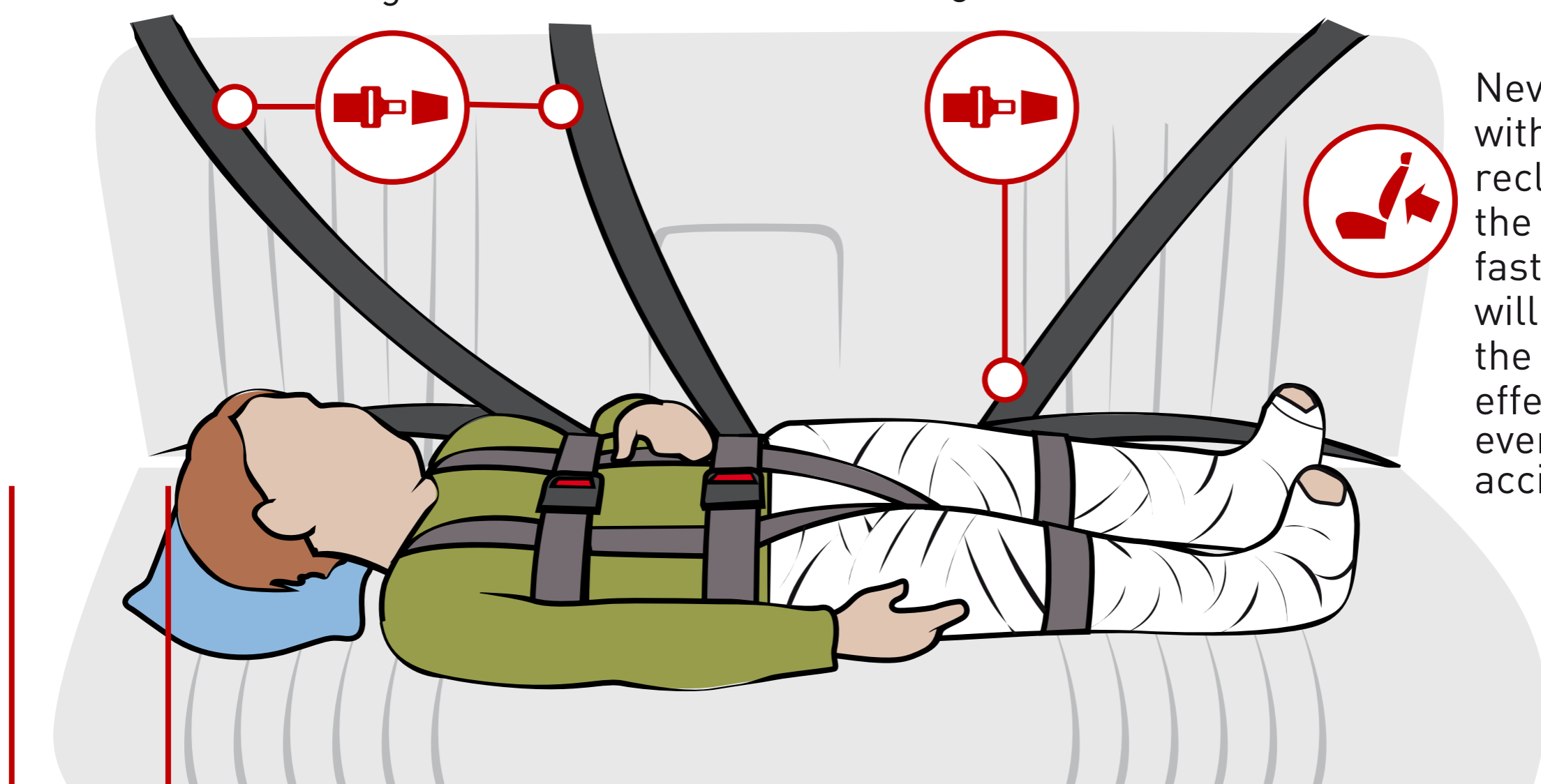
In these cases, used an E-Z On modified vest

You can place children over 2 years old and 9 kilos on their back or stomach to travel

The vest is fixed using the car seat belts

The third seat belt is used to strap legs in casts

Never travel with the seat reclined and the seat belt fastened; this will prevent the "submarine effect" in the event of an accident



Place the head as far away from the side of the car as possible to prevent injuries from side impact
